2019 Annual Report from The Arc of Whatcom County



With distribution to over 2,400 community members, our monthly newsletter provided information on relevant disability related topics, family perspectives, upcoming workshops, & community events.

The agency responded to 1,151 requests for personalized Oneon-One Assistance, Care Coordination, and Parent Matches on topics ranging from service navigation, evaluation & diagnosis, school services, housing, personal care issues, advocacy and coaching. Included were 26 families who received individualized assistance through the legal guardianship process, saving each family up to \$3,000 in legal fees.






Workshops, Support Groups and Networking Events attendance topped 1,177, while 218 community members participated in the annual Down syndrome Outreach "Buddy Walk" celebration.

Disability Awareness Presentations and Technical Assistance to Whatcom County Schools reached 822 staff, students, and families; topics included Self-Determination, Inclusion and Positive Behavior Supports.


